

## Hullett UNMASKED

Born on February 17, 1981 to Joel and Pat Hullett, in a small apartment complex outside of Brooklyn, New York, Henry is known to most people as just "HANK." A former basketball star turned entrepreneur and now majority owner and chairman of "HH, Inc.", Hullett's rise to fame and fortune was not always an easy one.

It was there Hank saw his calling. In 2007, with Brady and Moss both on his team putting up ridiculous point totals, Hullett caught the eye of a talent scout for a league just coming into its own... Taf Bentley. Bentley, having just joined a league known as DOL back in 2005 was on a mission by current commissioner, Bryan Hathaway to improve the product. Hullett instantly caught his eye and in the offseason of 2009, a DOL invitation was extended to Hullett.

It was instant success and riches for Hank as he instantly rose through the ranks of DOL. Hullett set what still stands today as the Longest Single Season Winning Streak at 9, on his way to an impressive 10-2 season and a Division Championship. He followed that performance up with a trip to DOL BOWL VIII the following season, but came up just short to his mentor- Taf Bentley. With the exception of a nude picture scandal that plagued HH, inc. in 2011, Hullett has been a force to be reckoned with in DOL, posting a Final Four Appearance despite the 2011 distraction and a top 5 playoff appearance in 2012.
